We don't start the program or start any medications in the initial consultation. If you choose to continue with us you will need to book a follow up extended appointment onsite or video appointment (your 2nd visit) to begin the program. Medicare only funds phone or video consults after an initial face to face appointment
- We don't have any lock in or sign up fees, We don't sell or promote any particular brand or products.
- As doctors we offer you our support and expertise to assist you on your weight loss journey though face to face, phone and video consultations. Medication prescriptions can be sent as e-scripts.
- We see you approximately once a month, (more often if you need more support) and charge fees according to the length of appointment, See above fee list.
- As much as we try to, we cant promise to run on time as we are also GP's looking after sick and vulnerable patients.
